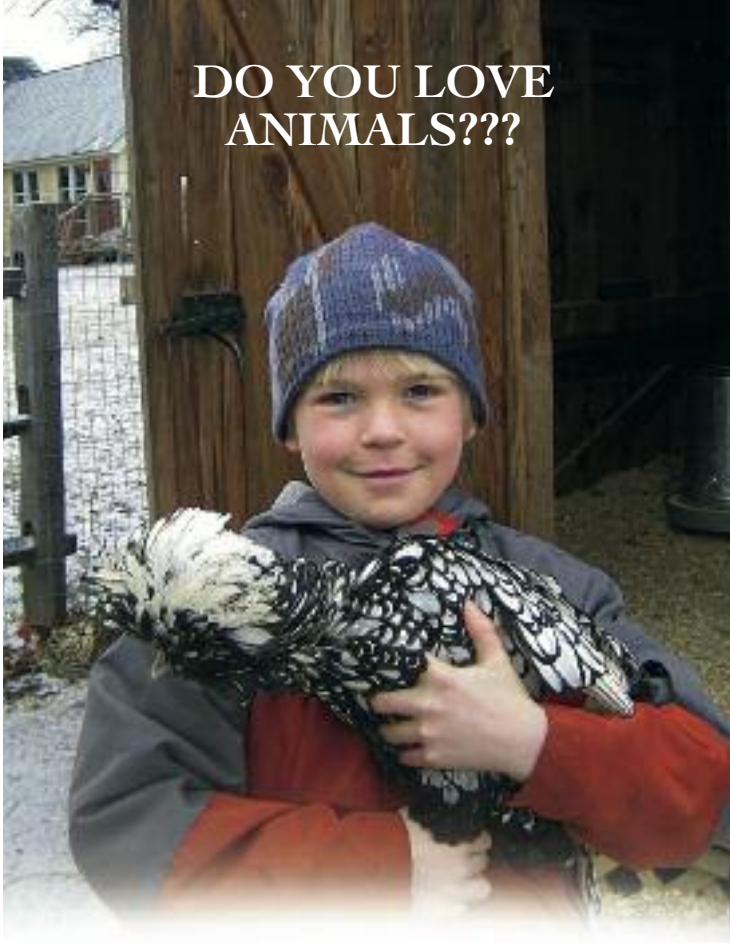


DO YOU LOVE ANIMALS???

WHY DOES A FARM NEED ANIMALS?

Many children today have little or no opportunity to learn about animals in a farm setting. At Farm Camp children are introduced to the role of animals on the farm through hands-on activities and agricultural crafts.

Farm Camp is to be held at the Farmstead of The Hartsbrook School in Hadley, and is directed by Nicki Robb. Nicki has received a Diploma in Curative Education, Camphill Rudolf Steiner Schools, Scotland, and a Master's Degree in Education from The University of Massachusetts. Nicki is a Co-Founder of Brookfield Farm in Amherst, MA and former Director of The School-To-Farm Program at Hampshire College.

A TYPICAL DAY AT CAMP:

- 8:45am **Arrival:** visiting with the animals, morning circle activities.
- 9:30 **Around the Barnyard:** milking the mother goats and Heather-Bell, our Jersey cow, feeding chicks and lambs, grooming goats and caring for Francesca the donkey.
- 10:30 **Snack**
- 10:45 **Agricultural Crafts:** candle-making, butter and cheese making, bread-baking, papermaking and weaving.
- 11:45 **Farm Journaling** activity
- 12:15pm **Lunch**
- 12:45 **Story-time**
- 1:45 **Games/Water Activities** (in summer)
- 2:30 **Around the Barnyard**
- 3:00 **Campers leave for the Day**
