5. Once your child's application, application fee, school records and any other supporting materials have been received, the Enrollment Director will contact you to:
 - Schedule a parental interview with a member of the faculty.
 - Schedule a school visit. Applicants to grades 2 - 8 visit the class for three consecutive days of school. A Visitors Emergency Information Form must be filled out and left with the office before students can visit unaccompanied by a parent or guardian.
6. After receipt of an acceptance letter and tuition contract, return your contract with requested tuition deposit. We cannot hold a place in a class until we have received the contract and deposit.
